Crosstabulation Results

#### *Methodology:*

This poll was conducted between February 18-February 18, 2022 among a sample of 1001 Adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Adults based on age, gender, educational attainment, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.
